Garbage Collection is picked up curbside on Tuesdays & Fridays

Please place your garbage at the curb before 7 A.M.

Garbage cans should be no more than 32 gallons in size, and no more than 3 containers per collection day.

Do not place containers near parked cars, basketball goals, low branches or wires. A distance of 40' must be kept away from "Stop" signs.

Please keep a 4' distance between your garbage canister, your recycling bin and other objects like plants or mailboxes.

Garbage Not Accepted:


- Paint
- Tires

Holidays Observed

New Year's Day Memorial Day Independence Day Labor Day Thanksgiving Day Christmas Day

If you have service on Monday and it is one time per week and the Holiday falls on Monday you will be serviced on Tuesday

If you have service on Monday and Thursday and the Holiday falls on one of your service days you will be serviced one time that week



Recycling Collection is every other week on <u>Wednesday</u> (see schedule below)

Please place your 18 Gallon Recycling bin at the curb before 7A.M. on your collection day.

What is Recyclable?

- Newspapers and inserts
- Aluminum Cans
- Plastic Containers (Number 1 thru 7) (no plastic bags)
- Corrugated Cardboard Containers-Includes Pizza Boxes, Cereal Boxes, etc.
- Brown Paper Bags
- Paper-All Colors, Office Paper, Copy Paper, Printer Paper
- Magazines, Catalogs, Junk Mail, Phone Books
- · Tin and Ferrous Cans
- Household Dry Cell Batteries (No Wet Cell Batteries)

What is **not** accepted for Recycling?

- No petroleum or hazardous waste containers.
- No broken or sheet glass.
- No plastic bags



Remember, the success of this system relies on recycling rather than throwing away, so please recycle all of the items mentioned!



Yard Waste Collection is every other week on Wednesday (see schedule below) Please place your yard waste at the curb before 7 A.M. on your service day.

Yard Waste Specifications:

- Any yard waste containing household garbage will not be picked up with yard waste. When household garbage is included, it is not permitted to be dumped at the yard debris dump site.
- Loose yard waste must be placed in containers, not plastic garbage bags.
- The collection crew is not responsible for picking up any uncontainerized debris.
- · Maximum weight of any item is 40 pounds.
- · Branches and tree twigs must be bundled
- Limbs up to 4" in diameter and up to 4' in length may be stacked in piles that weigh no more than 40 pounds.
- Any limbs that are larger must be cut to meet the length and weight requirements.

What is not accepted as Yard Waste?

- Wood Building Material
- Chemically Treated Wood-such as railroad ties
 These items must be cut to size and placed for collection on your garbage pickup day.

Yard Waste outside these specifications can be picked up for an additional fee. Please call Florida Express Environmental 352-369-5411 for an estimate.



Pickup for bulk items is by appointment only and must be prepaid.

Schedule an appointment for pickup of the following:

- Furniture
- Large Single Household Items
- Larger Amounts of Debris-such as sheds, fencing, roofing, decking, etc.
- Garage Clean-outs
- White Goods-Large Household Appliances
